*We believe there is no limit to the variety of ways students learn as long as they are done in a stimulating, safe atmosphere with equal opportunity to all.*





## **Option A**

### **260 Total Credits**

30 Credits of Math—Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II

30 Credits of Science—Physical Science, Biology, and Chemistry

An additional 10 credits of Math or Science—Physics, Advanced Math, Advanced Biology, or Calculus

40 Credits of Language Arts to include 10 credits of class with speech component.

40 Credits of Social Science—10 Credits of American Government, 20 Credits of American History, 10 Credits of Social Science elective.

10 Credits of Physical Education I

20 Credits of Foreign Language—Must be in one area.

10 Credits of fine arts—Music, Drama, or Art.

10 Credits of Life Skills—General Business, Accounting, Adult Living, Independent Living, Industrial Arts or Vocational Agriculture.

## **Option B**

### **260 Total Credits**

30 Credits of Math—Algebra A, Algebra B (equivalent to Algebra I), and Math Concepts

30 Credits of Science

40 Credits of Language Arts—10 to include class with a speech component.

40 Credits of Social Science—10 American Government, 20 American History, and 10 Credits of Social Science elective.

10 Credits of Physical Education I

10 Credits of Fine Arts—Music, Art, or Drama

50 Credit Vocational Major—Family Consumer Science, Business, Industrial Tech-

IEP student diploma options

Option 1—Complete standard course of study meeting all graduation requirements and IEP/Transition goals

Option 2—Completes standard or modified course of study but not IEP/Transition goals. Receives regular diploma upon completion of IEP/Transition goal or end of school year when student turns 21.

Option 3—Student completes IEP/Transition goals but not standard course of study. Receive regular diploma upon complete of IEP/Transition goal if disability prevents student from completing standard course of study OR completion of standard course of study.
