DISCUSSION ON 2025-2026 BUDGET PRIORITIES

Discussion was held by Dr. Arlt and the Board regarding the 2025-2026 budget. The current draft asks for less property tax revenue than the previous year in the amount of \$106,993. This will result in a 48-cent levy for the general fund. The Special Building Fund will prioritize the paving of Lincoln Avenue and bus barn and stadium/press box renovations in the next 2 fiscal years. The SBF levy would be 4.3 cents for a total levy of 52.6 cents, which would be the lowest levy in school history.
